3. A deficit of established research into the benefits of osteopathy



The Graduate Associate Programme;

Making the transition from student to professional osteopath can be a daunting experience, as suddenly developing and running a business becomes as vital a skill as clinical training and therapeutic judgement. Osteopathy has long had a problem with a lack of mentoring and career progression. CORE Clapton addresses this by ensuring its graduates are fully supported and advised in the critical first year of their professional career.

- Access to mentoring from experienced senior osteopaths on both therapeutic and business management matters as you start out as an independent practitioner
